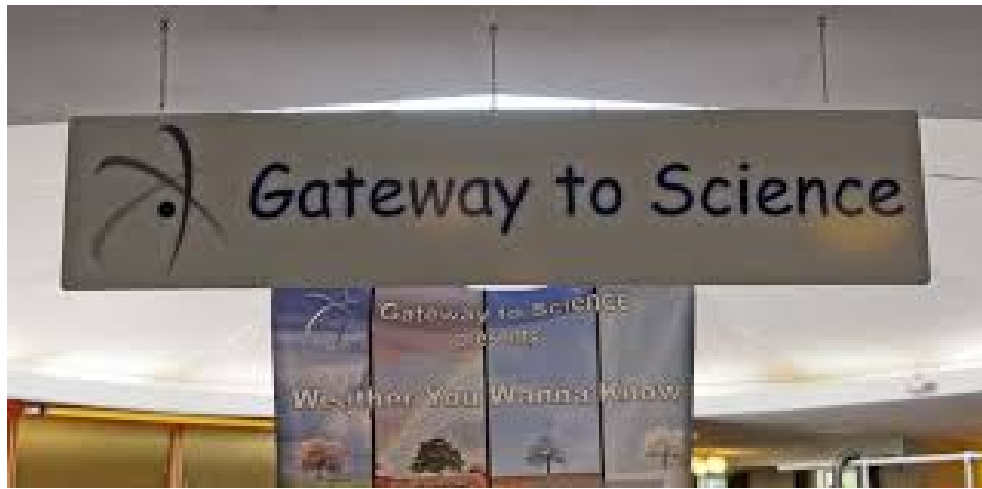
NEXT PTL MEETING

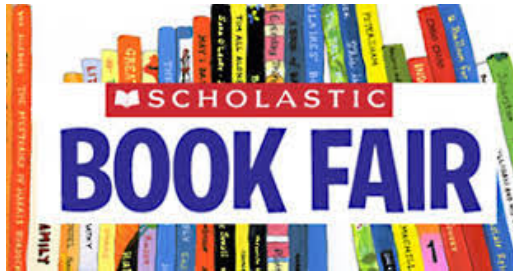
