* Cut-off birthdates for all sections is July 31st (4/5's must be 4 years of age by July 31st and 3's likewise).

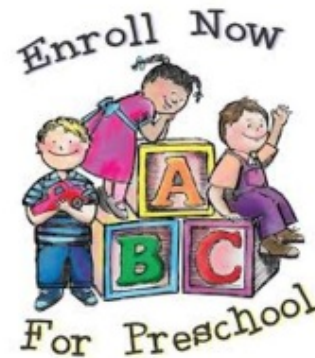
* All students must be fully potty trained in order to register.
