This week we remember our MLS families. If you know of a family you would like us to include in our prayers, please let the office know.

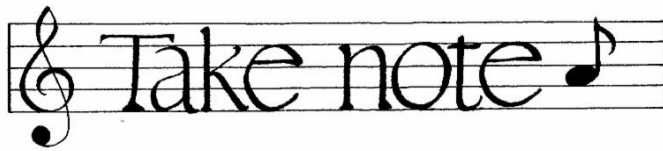
Pastor Zellers will be leading chapel Wednesday, May 15th at 8:30am.

Greetings Parents and Students,
We at TruNorth Theatre are bringing a summer theatre experience to your community for students' ages 8-18.

This summer's production will be *Peter Pan and Wendy* by James M. Barrie adapted by J. Clemo. Students will be introduced to the world of theatre over this 5-week process, and at the end will present a fully realized production. All students who register will be cast.
Rehearsal information:

- Rehearsals will be held M-F from 9am-12pm at Martin Luther Elementary School
- Rehearsals will run June 10th – July 10th with no rehearsal July 3-5th.
- Dress Rehearsals will be held July 8th – July 11th and attendance is mandatory.
- Performances will be held July 12th, 13th, and 14th.

Cost:

- Cost is \$300 per student with a \$25 discount per additional child per family
- A \$150 deposit is due with your registration with the remaining \$150 paid before the first rehearsal.

- Scholarships are available for students in financial need. Please email TruNorth Theatre for scholarship applications.

Registration:

- **Registration is due by May 8th**
- Registration can be emailed or mailed
- Registration is dependent on a minimum program participation of 10 students. If 10 students have not registered by the deadline families will be contacted and registration fees will be returned.
- Participation may be capped if program numbers become too high or an afternoon session may be added.
