At MLS we offer many food options during our lunch time and do our absolute best to help each student leave lunch time satisfied. Salad bar is always available along with our main menu item, fruit, vegetable, meat/meat alternate, bread/grain, milk and water. Many times there is even more offered than the state of ND requires. We don't want our students to be hungry. "Hangry" students don't feel well and they don't learn at the optimum level they can. So, we are happy at MLS to do what we can to encourage great brain health and the best learning opportunity possible.

The state of ND does suggest that we share three things with our students'

families about the Offer vs. Serve program ND Foods requires each school follows. We want to share this so there is no confusion as to why each student is not required to take certain things, etc.

- All five required food components must be offered to all students: Fruit, Vegetable, Meat/Meat alternate, Bread/Grain and Milk.
- Students must take at least three of the five food components. One must be a fruit or a vegetable or fruit/vegetable mixture. The other two can be from any food components.
- No one is required to take protein or milk.

If you have any questions, please make sure to ask. We are looking forward to a great school year!

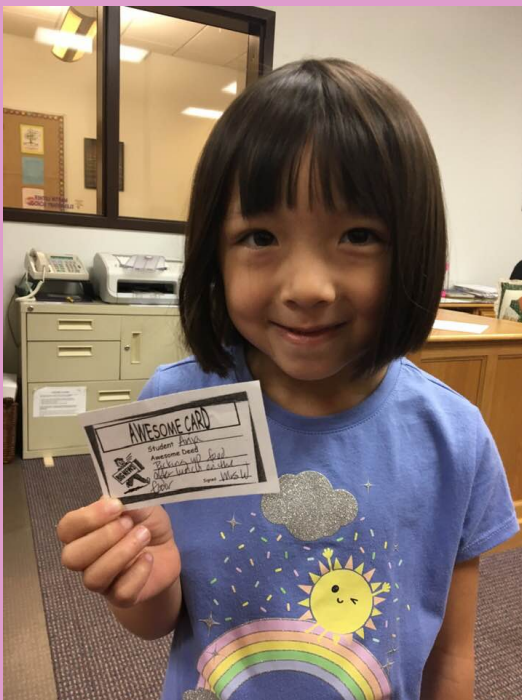
Help wanted
