### Dear Parents:

This year's Christmas concert is almost here! Next Thursday, December 14<sup>th</sup> will be a busy day with dress rehearsal in the morning and the evening's performance. Please take note of the following important details.

Thursday morning, December 14, our day will begin at Bismarck Baptist Church, 2211 Laforest Avenue. We are asking, if possible, for students to be dropped off at BBC beginning at 8:00 a.m. We will have teachers there when they open the doors at 8:00 am. Students should be dropped off by 8:15 a.m. Dropping off at BBC will help reduce the number of students who need to be bussed over.

We know many of you will not be able to do this because you need to drop your students off earlier than 8:00. ABC Care will

still be available at the school. All students who need to use ABC Care or for whom it is difficult to be dropped off at BBC will be bussed up to the church. The bus will leave MLS promptly at 8:15 a.m. It is important that students not be late that day.

We will have a Christmas concert dress rehearsal on Thursday, December 14th at 10:30 a.m. You are welcome to join us! If you know someone who cannot attend on Thursday evening, invite them to come to the dress rehearsal.

**ATTIRE:** For the Thursday evening performance, students should wear their 'Sunday Best.' Boys: dark pants and a nice sweater or shirt and tie would be appropriate. Girls: a dress, skirt or dressy pants. Please NO jeans or t-shirts.

Thursday dress rehearsal- red, white or black top  
On Thursday evening all students should arrive at Bismarck Baptist Church by 6:45 p.m. [Note to band and handbell choir members: your directors may give you additional instructions for when and where to report.] Parents are responsible for their own children until 6:45 as the teachers will be busy with final preparations.
