COMMUNICABLE DISEASES

When any symptom of a communicable disease appears, please keep your child at home. We also request that you observe the "24-hour" rule. Wait until your child is fever-free, vomit and diarrhea free for at least 24 hours before returning to school. Please DO NOT send your child to school on days when any of these symptoms are present: Fever of 100 degrees or more, vomiting or diarrhea, inflammation, crusting or redness of the eye, any contagious or infectious disease of the skin, mouth or eyes or unidentified rash, chronic cough that could be contagious or disruptive to the learning environment, sore throat with fever and/or swollen glands, heavy nasal discharge/mucous-any color (the first two to three days of mucous are contagious). Prescribed medication for contagious illnesses must be taken for a full 24 hours before returning to school.

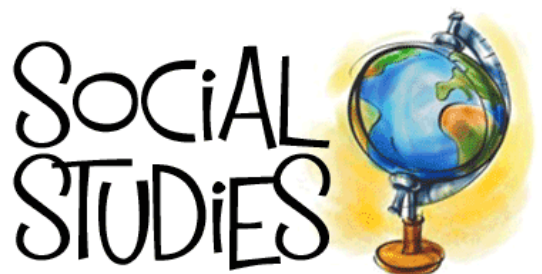
