National Lutheran Schools Week 2020

“Joy-Fully Lutheran”

During National Lutheran Schools Week, we want to take the opportunity to give thanks to God for all the good things He’s given to us by giving back to others. Quarter Wars is a fun way for students to compete against each other and raise money. This year, our Quarter Wars funds will support Lutheran Hour Ministries – Mongolia. We’ll be learning more about this special ministry during our Online Mission Trips to Mongolia.

Here’s how Quarter Wars works:

- Each classroom will be given a tub for boys and a tub for girls.
- Students are encouraged to put their change in these tubs. Each coin has a different value:

Pennies = +1 point

Nickels = +5 points

Dimes = +10 points

Quarters = -25 points

- Since quarters are worth negative points, you want to put them in the other team’s tub, while filling your team’s tub with dimes, nickels, and pennies.
- For example, if you brought in 4 dimes, 2 nickels, and 5 pennies, you would be putting 55 points into your tub.
- If someone put a quarter in your tub, 25 points would be deducted from your team, and your score would now be 30.

Paper money and checks, although counted in the dollar amount for our mission project, will not count for or against the point total for each team.

The winning teams will win a SURPRISE (Most likely edible)!!
