Family Reading Night: Score with Reading

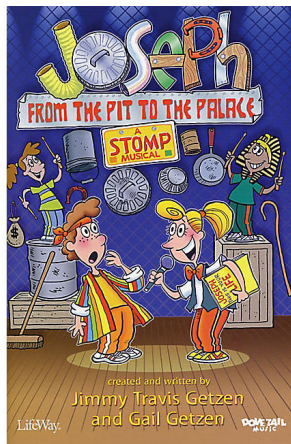
